1. Application Deadline

Fall Semester (begins September and ends January)	Before March 30
Spring Semester (begins February and ends June)	Before October 30

2. Application Procedure

Prospective exchange students should submit the following documents:

- (1) Application Form (please include a passport-sized photo)
- (2) Autobiography and Study Plan
- (3) Two recommendation letters
- (4) A copy of your passport
- (5) Official transcript (English version)

Cost of Housing	Free(the principle of equality and mutual benefit)
Living Cost	Living expenses range from \$6,000 to \$12,000 NTD per month, depending on individual lifestyle.(the principle of equality and mutual benefit)

5. Visa | Alien Residence Certificate (ARC)

<p>Resident Visa (for more than six months)</p>	<p>Foreign nationals who hold ordinary passports or other legal travel documents and intend to stay in the Republic of China (Taiwan) for more than six months may apply for resident visa.</p> <p>* Please Download the application form at: http://www.boca.gov.tw/public/Data/832510505771.pdf</p>
<p>Alien Residence Certificate (ARC)</p>	<p>Resident visa holder must apply for ARC within 15 days following the date of entrance or the approval date of the resident visas at the National Immigration Agency. When applying for the ARC, one may simultaneously apply for a re-entry permit. The re-entry permit allows you to leave and return to Taiwan.</p> <p>* Please Download application form: http://www.immigration.gov.tw/immigration/FileSystem/Application/App111.pdf</p>
<p>Visa Extension</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Foreign nationals holding visitor visa and wishing to stay more than 6 months after their arrival should apply for changing to resident visa with the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA). 2. Foreign nationals holding visitor visa and wishing to stay less than 6 months are not required to change their visa status. However, if they intend to stay longer than their visa expiration date, they do need to apply for visa extensions through National Immigration Agency before the expiration date. <p>*Required documents: Documents issued outside of Taiwan MUST be translated into Chinese or English and certified by an ROC Embassy, Consulate, or Trade Office abroad. (Original is required for application.)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. An application form B. Passport (original to be returned after verification) C.
